Iran has completed a power transmission line and pole to Azerbaijan which could swap some 600 megawatts of electricity between the two countries.

Iran-Turkmenistan \$2.5 billion agreement was finalized. Iran will import about 30 billion worth gas from Turkmenistan in the next 10 years, while exporting \$30 billion worth technical and engineering worth goods and services to the country.

Spanish Repsol company entered contract with Iran in July for import of one million barrels of crude. The exports will add up to the volume of Iran's oil exports to Europe.

Tehran and Astana are due to cooperate in building an oil refinery in Northern Iran which will refine Kazakhstan's oil for foreign exports.

India lifted a ban on trade of specified items with Iran as a result of a nuclear agreement between Tehran and six world powers.

The Fourth Iran International Maritime Industries Exhibition (Iran-IMEX 2016) will be held in Tehran from September 24-26 concurrent with the World Maritime Day.

Plan for Iran's gas export to Iraq had been slated for about two years ago, but it was postponed due to insecurity in that country. Iran will start exporting gas to Iraq in the near future.

Iran stands the third major supplier of oil to India after Saudi Arabia and Iraq for exporting more than 500,000 bpd crude to the country.

The loading operation of gas platform of the Phase 21 of South Pars opened in a ceremony attended by several local and oil officials in this southwestern province.

The contract has been signed with the Japanese for feasibility studies on a project to decrease kiln oil production in Tehran Refinery.
